Parking and Transit Options for State Employees in the Sacramento Region

To facilitate parking and commute logistics for California State employees adjusting to a four day in-office weekly schedule effective July 1st, 2026, the California Government Operations Agency in partnership with the Department of General Services (DGS) and the Department of Human Resources (CalHR) has compiled the below list of parking and transit resources for State employees.

Accessing State Managed Parking

DGS manages 17 state-owned parking facilities in the greater downtown Sacramento region. Access to parking at each individual DGS managed facility can be obtained via a monthly subscription. Select locations also offer daily parking rates.

Access to Monthly Parking Subscriptions >

Affordable monthly parking subscriptions are offered at all DGS managed parking locations in the Sacramento region. Parking spaces for new subscribers are offered on a flow basis dictated by cancellations from existing subscribers. New spaces are accessible via a waitlist on a per facility basis for tenant-owned facilities and are accessible via the Online Parking Lottery System for DGS-owned facilities.

Access to Daily Parking >

Daily parking is accessible at three DGS managed facilities in central downtown Sacramento and at the Richards Blvd Office Complex. Daily parking access is offered on a first come first serve basis until capacity at the given facility is full. Daily parking rates and hours of operation vary on a per facility basis.

City of Sacramento Freeway Lot >

The city of Sacramento manages a parking lot at 6th/8th & W/X streets under the freeway. This parking facility can be accessed via a daily fee of \$3 or a monthly subscription of \$65.
